2) Finances

3) AOB

- a) restriction placed on New Forest race entrants removed
- b) Foxlease possibly available as cc6 venue if required though not needed for this season
- c) medals only to be awarded to overall male/female league winners – winners in vets categories not to be awarded medals but recorded on web page
- d) race scoring – to remain as per present method (no percentage positions) and race results to be e-mailed by each club to martin.loveless@btinternet.com as soon as possible after race finish for compilation and entry onto web rather than paper collection after the run. Martin to forward onto Malcolm for Echo report.
- e) Echo report – any related running stories welcomed by Malcolm for adding onto cc6 report.
- f) club scoring – agreement that if clubs did not have enough runners entered to field team then either finisher of alternate sex could be added onto score to make up team or last places in field could be used
- g) first aid – reminder that all clubs should have adequate first-aid cover available and marshals have means of communication should there be a problem – either walkie talkies (available from Martin Loveless) or mobiles.
- h) removal of cc6 time limits – not agreed
